

# Installing IE Tab Browser Extension to Use Internet EDI in Google Chrome

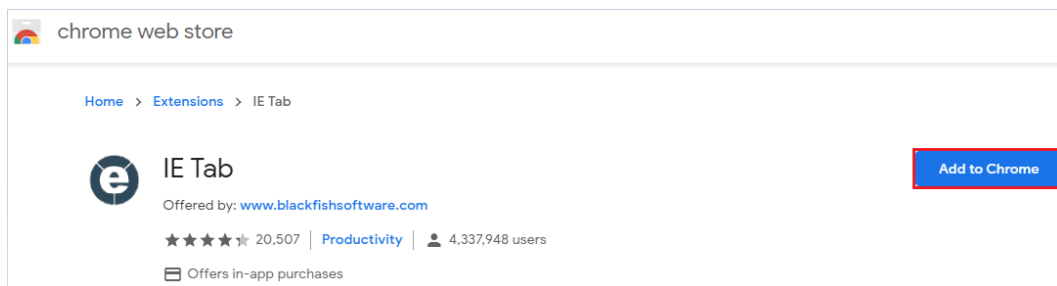
Internet EDI is a Silverlight application which, by default, is not supported by the Google Chrome browser. However, installing the IE Tab browser extension will allow you to use Silverlight and run Internet EDI in Chrome.

Note: If Silverlight is not already installed, go to the following link to install it - <https://www.microsoft.com/getsilverlight/Get-Started/Install/Default>

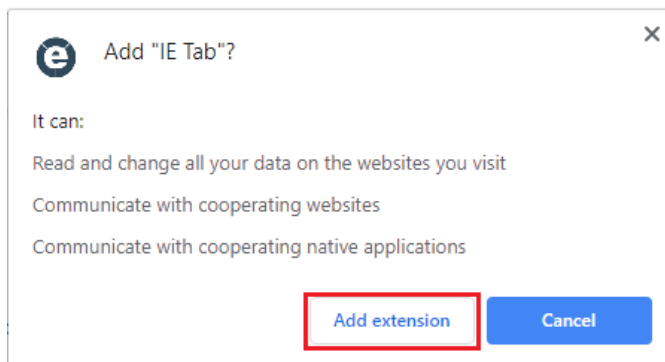
## How to Install the IE Tab Browser Extension

1. Open Google Chrome and go to the following link - <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/ie-tab/hehijbfgiekmjfkfjpbkbammjbdnadd>

2. Click on 'Add to Chrome'



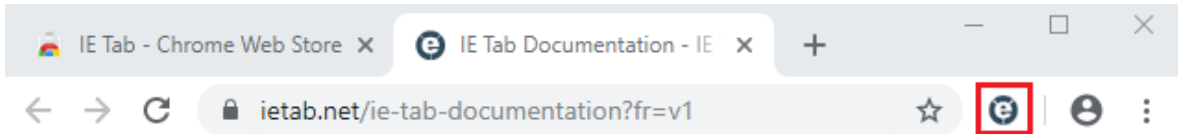
3. You will be presented with the following pop-up. Click on 'Add extension'.





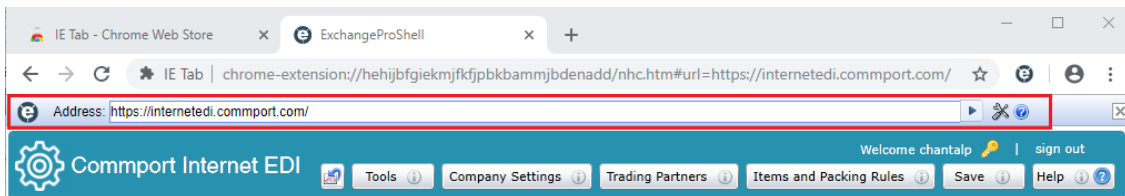

4. Once the IE Tab browser extension has been installed, you should see the IE Tab icon to the right of the Chrome address bar.



## How to Use Internet EDI in Google Chrome

1. Click on the IE Tab icon, which will add a second address bar below the Chrome address bar.



2. Use this new address bar to navigate to Internet EDI - <https://internetedi.commport.com/>
3. You can now use Internet EDI just as you would in the Internet Explorer browser.
